Lost in Translation" - Hermeneutics

2 Peter 1:1-10

Author - Simon Peter, the chief Apostle of Jesus Christ

Audience - Peter stated that he was writing "to them that have obtained like precious faith with us" (2 Peter 1:1). This may indicate that Peter's audience was the same Gentile Christians who received Peter's First Epistle (see 2 Peter 3:1).

Context - 3 Objectives

- 1. Encouraged to continue to grow always.
- 2. Warned about immoral living (particularly from Church leaders)
- 3. Warned about twisted theology.

Lens - The content of 2 Peter 1:12–15 shows that Peter meant this letter to be a farewell message to his readers.
